

Dear Columbia Gas Customer:

We are writing to notify that our contractor Miller Pipeline is getting set to begin a pipeline replacement project in Leetonia. Crews will be installing approximately 10,600 feet of new plastic pipe serving roughly 130 residences in the area generally bounded by Summit, Front, Oak, and Chestnut.

In terms of timing, preconstruction camera work is in progress. During this phase, residents may notice markers and flags cropping up in yards. These are to mark the locations of underground facilities. We kindly ask that everyone keep all markers in place until our work is complete.

Installation of the new mainline should then begin the week of August 8. Once the mainline is in and put into service, crews will follow-up with service line replacements for individual homes. These take about 2-4 hours per property and include a brief service disconnection. Indoor meters will be relocated outside as well. Miller personnel will reach out to schedule an appointment with each property owner during this phase.

As for restoration, crews will temporarily restore all property to ensure safety and accessibility and then follow-up with permanent restoration as the project nears completion.
